Rock effigies are abundant at the springs, which point to the likelihood that this was a water temple for early civilizations. The Creek and Cherokee Nations both valued the spring as a healing spring. To determine who had guardian rights, the two nations played a lacrosse game in which the Cherokee Nation won.

In 1888, a grand hotel opens near the springs. Advertised as a healing ground, it attracts the likes of famous writers, wealthy families, and United States Presidents. A short rail line, "The Little Anna", carries passengers from the Austell Train Depot to the Hotel.
